If you're planning on staying longer than 90 days, but aren't yet sure about permanent residence, you'll need a Schengen Treaty/Tourist Visa. Most people who are not part of the EU must obtain a visa to work and live long-term in Italy and I was no exception. The thing is, like the Pope and the government — Italy LOVES to shake things up - including laws on immigrants working in the country. Work strawberry picking can be found in the Emilia Romagna region in June and Apples in August/September in the regions of Valtellina and Alto Adige. The grape harvest takes place in the North West of Italy, in vineyards South East of Turin and Piemonte, West of Verona and in Alto Adige in September and October. If you are from outside the EU and planning to visit Italy solely as a volunteer and not as a tourist you will need the correct visa.
